Echinacea is a favorite in perennial gardens as a cut flower, a butterfly magnet, and even as a medicinal herb. Great for massing and is drought tolerant. Likes well drained soil and sun to part sun. Deadhead to encourage more flowers. Native to the eastern US.

'Harvest Moon'

24" Rich, bright yellow, brown cone, blooms in July, will rebloom with deadheading, compact and sturdy.

'Kim's Knee High'

12-24" Rose-pink flowers, blooms July-September, compact selection, sun to part shade.

'Little Magnus'

14-18' Large deep pink cone flowers, compact habit, a dwarf 'Magnus'.

'Magnus'

36" Deep, rose-pink, blooms June-September, large non-drooping blooms. 1998 Plant of the Year.

'Milkshake'

30-36" Fully double creamy-white pompom like flowers, ray of petals droop downward, long lasting blooms.

'Paradoxa'

32" Bright yellow flowers, late summer, petals are narrow and drooping.

'Pink Double Delight'

18-24" True pink pompom flowers, blooms July-September, compact and well branched.

'Ruby Star'

36-40" Rich, raspberry-pink flowers, blooms June-September, sun to part shade, similar to 'Magnus' with stiff petals, vigorous.

'Sundown'

36-30" Intense, orange flowers, blooms June-September, prolific and sturdy.

'Sunrise'

30-36" Citron yellow, blooms June-September, vigorous, rose scented.

'White Swan'

18-24" Almost white flowers, blooms June-September, large sturdy flowers.
