**'Acre'** 1-2", *Goldmoss Stonecrop*, is a tiny pale green spreading stonecrop which blooms May & June, when the tiny yellow flowers lend it the appearance of a golden moss. Excellent for rock gardens; will not tolerate foot traffic, groundcover, prefers sandy or gravelly soil, sun to partial shade. **NEW.**

**'Angelina'** 3-6", golden yellow to coppery foliage, nice as a groundcover or used in containers, nice contrast to purple foliage, sun.

**'Autumn Joy'** 24", deep pink flat flower clusters, September-October, great with ornamental grasses for four season garden interest, sun.

**'Blue Spruce'** 4-8", bright yellow flowers, mid-summer, fleshy blue-green needle like foliage, dense and mat forming, sun.

**'Fuldaglut'** 4", soft rose red flowers, early to late summer, bronze red foliage, sun.

**'Garnet Brocade'** 12-24", garnet red flowers, late summer into fall, heat and drought tolerant, sun.

**'Hab Grey'** 12-20", upright Stonecrop, smoky gray foliage accented by rose pink, arching stems. Pink buds open to lemon-centered cream flowers in late summer. Combine with succulent temperennials to create an exotic looking xeriscape. **NEW.**

**'John Creech'** 2-3", pinkish purple flowers, mid to late summer, scalloped bright green foliage forms a thick mat, full to part sun.

**'Maestro'** 24-30", sturdy clump of blue-green foliage, retains its tidy, mounded shape every year and does not open up in the center like other Sedums do over time, rose-pink flowers.

**'Major'** classic evergreen perennial groundcover forms a low carpet of tiny round powdery blue-grey leaves, remaining evergreen in mild regions. Clusters of white star

flowers appear in early summer. A perfect choice for the rock garden, between stepping stones or in the crevices of dry walls. **NEW.**

**'Munstead Dark Red'** 18-23", older but reliable selection of upright Stonecrop, excellent for late summer and fall interest. This British selection produces branching heads of crimson-rose flowers, over a mound of succulent green leaves that are tinged red during summer. Dried seed-heads have good winter interest. Sometimes floppy in moist and rich sites; pinch growth back by half in June to reduce height if desired. Outstanding cut flower, and also attracts butterflies. Easily divided in spring. **NEW.**

**'Neon'** 18-24", shocking pink, July-August, vibrant and exciting from a good distance away, deer resistant, sun.

**'Pink Bomb'** 12", pink cluster, late August thru frost, green blue foliage, sun.

**'Red Carpet'** 3-4", red tinged foliage, deep carmine red flowers, late summer, drought tolerant, sun.

**'Sieboldii'** 6-10", silver blue scalloped foliage, bright pink flower clusters in late September to October, great ground cover with daylilies, sun.

**'Sunset Cloud'** 6-12", arching, blue steel foliage with plum highlights is low growing and compact. Purple foliage emerges green before transforming to dark purple tones as the season progresses. The late summer flowers are small, bright and rosy red making a beautiful color combination. Well, suited to hot, dry conditions. A wonderful, easy and very low maintenance perennial. **NEW.**

**'Tetractinum'** 3", bright yellow flower clusters in summer, foliage is green in summer turning.

**'Tri Color'** 3-6", star shaped pink flowers, May-September, green leaves with pink and white variegation, sun.
